Gate Passes

Come see the 160th Antigonish Highland Games on Us! With this summer being the 160th anniversary of the Games, the Antigonish Highland Society is pleased to offer free day passes for everyone! There will be no daytime admission charged at the gate for Saturday and Sunday events, thank you to everyone for making this event a success for over 160 years!

Competition Rules

- 1. Dancers will be judged according to the technique of the RSOBHD. Scrutineering will be conducted as recommended by the RSOBHD.
- 2. First to enter, last to dance.
- 3. Age as of July 12, 2025 for Novice & Intermediate dancers. Age as of July 13, 2025 for Primary & Beginner. Age categories for all Pre-Premier groups and Special Events will be based on entries received.
- 4. Judges' decision is final. No access to judges' sheets.
- 5. Dancers must report promptly to line up area when called or risk disqualification.
- 6. No refunds after entries are received. Late entries if accepted (after June 27, 2025) will be charged an additional \$20 late fee.
- 7. Dancers will pick up numbers at the registration desk upon verification of RSOBHD card.
- 8. Dancers must be in full costume to receive awards. No sneakers allowed.
- 9. Medals will be awarded in all Pre-Premier categories, and Special Events. High Aggregate and Runner-Up trophies in all groups except Primary.
- 10. Absolutely no coaching by parents/teachers/dancers while dancers are on the stage.
- 11. No teachers or parents are allowed in the Marshalling area, other than those volunteering. The marshalling area includes the entire backstage under the big tent, only dancers called to dance and volunteers are allowed in the marshalling area.
- 12. The Antigonish Highland Society will not be responsible for lost items, accidents, or personal injury at the event.
- 13.In the event of a protest being lodged, a fee of \$25 must accompany a written complaint no later than 48 hours after the event. The fee will be returned if the protest is upheld.

New Scotland Open Championship Rules

- 1. Sanctioned and conducted under the rules of the RSOBHD.
- 2. Age as of July 12, 2025.
- 3. The 2024 RSOBHD Championship steps must be danced.
- 4. Championship groups must have a minimum of six dancers competing to be eligible for Championship status.
- 5. In the event of there being insufficient entries in the stated age groups, prior to, or on the day of the event, the organizers will amalgamate age groups to meet the minimum required numbers. All dancers ages 12 & over will be required to dance long steps regardless of the Championship status of their group.
- 6. First to enter, last to dance. No number draw.
- 7. Dancers will be asked to fill in for the reel as required.
- 8. Judges' decision is final. No access to judges' sheets. Championship results will be posted.
- 9. Medals will be awarded to 6 places in each dance. Cash awards to the oldest group. Keeper awards to the Champion and 5 Runner-Ups.

Highland Heart Open Premiership Rules

- 1. The Highland Heart Open Premiership is recognized by Scotdance Canada.
- 2. Age as of July 13, 2025.
- 3. The 2025 RSOBHD Premiership steps must be danced.
- 4. Premiership groups must have a minimum of six dancers to be eligible for Premiership status. In the event of insufficient dancers in predetermined groups on the day of the event, the organizer will amalgamate age groups to meet the minimum required numbers.
- 5. First to enter, last to dance. No number draw.
- 6. Judges' decision is final. No access to judges' sheets. Premiership results will be posted.
- 7. Medals will be awarded to 6 placings in each group. Cash awards to the oldest group. Keeper trophies will be awarded to the Premiership Winner and 5 Runner-Ups.

Premier Cash Prizes

Oldest Premier Group in the New Scotland Open Championship and the Highland Heart Open Premiership will receive cash Prizes: 1st \$50, 2nd \$40, 3rd \$35, 4th \$30, 5th \$25, 6th \$20.

Special Antigonish Town & County Trophies

Gerarda MacDonald/Janice Macquarrie Trophy is awarded to the top Premier dancer of the weekend who accumulates the most points in the Championship and Premiership. **Wilena MacInnis Penny Trophy** is awarded to the Antigonish Premier Dancer with the most points accumulated in the Championship, Premiership and Flora.

New Zealand Pre-Premier Trophy is awarded to the Antigonish Beginner, Novice, or Intermediate dancer deemed most promising by the judges.
